Half way of the event, the delegates could relax and discuss during the Catalan tastes that has become a traditional social event since the 1st Summer School, in 2016.

On Friday, 9th of June, the Best VPHi Poster Award was won by Andrea Nuesch, <u>Disc4All</u> <u>Project</u> PhD candidate, with the poster "The presence of Gram positive bacteria within intervertebral disc tissue and their potential influence".
